Commitment to Accessibility

Vivid Money is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for all users, including people with disabilities. We strive to provide an accessible online experience in accordance with the European Accessibility Act (EAA) and the European digital accessibility standard EN 301 549, which incorporates the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA criteria .
